*Affirmation of Faith

From the Second Helvetic Confession

We are justified by faith alone. We receive this justification, not through any works, but through faith in the mercy of God and in Christ. We therefore teach and believe with the apostle that sinful humanity is justified by faith alone in Christ, not by any works. For the apostle says: "We hold that a man is justified by faith apart from works of law," and "by grace you have been saved through faith; and this is not your own doing, it is the gift of God." Therefore, because faith receives Christ our righteousness and attributes everything to the grace of God in Christ, on that account justification is attributed to faith, chiefly because of Christ. It is the gift of God.
